Following the recent AGM it was agreed to maintain the subscription at £55.00 per household for the current financial year, and to take the opportunity of thanking all those who have contributed towards the road repairs (see attached list) during the last financial year, 1st June 2012 to 31st May 2013.

The attached photos show how the condition of the road deteriorates, and some of the maintenance work which has been carried out to keep it in good order. As well as all the potholes that have been filled, now in excess of 100, we have also completely resurfaced 3 areas, as shown in the photographs, covering a total length of almost 70 meters.
